

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 31 OF THE COMPETITION ACT NO. 12 OF 2010

The Competition Authority of Kenya (the Authority) is a State Corporation established by Section 7 of the Competition Act No. 12 of 2010 (the Act). The Authority's mandate is to enforce the Act with the objective of enhancing the welfare of the people of Kenya by controlling Abuse of Buyer Power, among others.

The Authority has commenced investigations into possible contraventions of the Act in the retail sector through delays in payment of suppliers without justifiable reason. Pursuant to Sections 24A(2) and 31(4)(a) of the Act, the Authority is requesting **Local Suppliers** owed by major retail supermarkets beyond a credit period of 90 days from the date of supply to submit information to the Authority.
